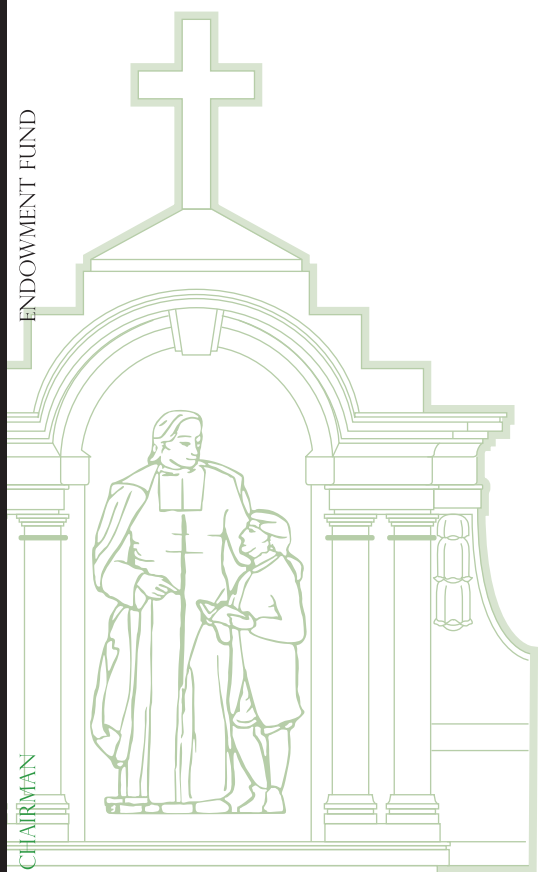

St Joseph's College 140th Anniversary Endowment Fund

St Joseph's College celebrates its 140th Anniversary this year. On this momentous occasion, I am pleased to announce that the college will launch the 140th Anniversary Endowment Fund in order to sustain and improve the college's position as a top tier secondary school in Hong Kong.

Throughout its long and distinguished history, the college has provided quality education to young men from all walks of life, many of whom have become leaders in Hong Kong in various fields including Nobel Prize Laureate, Sir Charles Kao.

Nevertheless, the educational environment in Hong Kong has changed. As a Lasallian school, we follow our mission to educate the poor. However, as a subsidized school that does not charge any fees, the school's finances are wholly dependent on Government. Regrettably, the subsidy is no longer adequate to meet today's needs in maintaining our position among the elite schools of Hong Kong.

We believe that creating an endowment fund is the best solution to providing sustainable, additional funding for the school. We hope to equip the school with extra resources to improve the quality and number of teachers; to improve school facilities and to introduce new, state-of-the-art learning programmes.

I am now calling on all SJC old boys and stakeholders to contribute generously to the 140th Anniversary Endowment Fund. The goal is to raise HK\$200 million in five years. With this amount and prudent investing, we hope to generate a healthy annual return (in the region of HK\$5-10million) with which the school can start making immediate improvements. It has been agreed that naming rights will be available for various parts of the school for a defined period, as a token of our recognition.

Your support of the SJC 140th Anniversary Endowment Fund would be greatly appreciated. With your support we are hopeful that St Joseph's College will remain as the best DSE secondary school in Hong Kong and continue to nurture future Hong Kong leaders.

How You Can Donate
